Students must understand that this is a selection process. Due to the amount of students interested, more than likely they may not be selected.

Students who return a permission slip *may* need to interview with the patrol for a position on the team, depending on the volume of responses. Once a selection is made the classes involved will be notified.

At the close of the school year we will again accept applications to build the patrol members for the 2010-2011 school year.
